Changes to the By-Laws are still in process and they were discussed in detail. A new draft should be available during the May meeting for all those in attendance, and mailed out to those unable to attend.

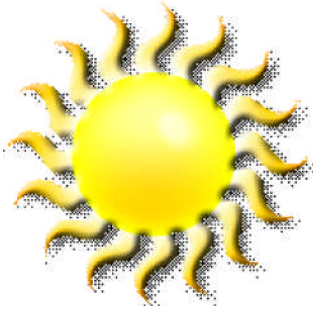
Gloria Farley won the drawing.

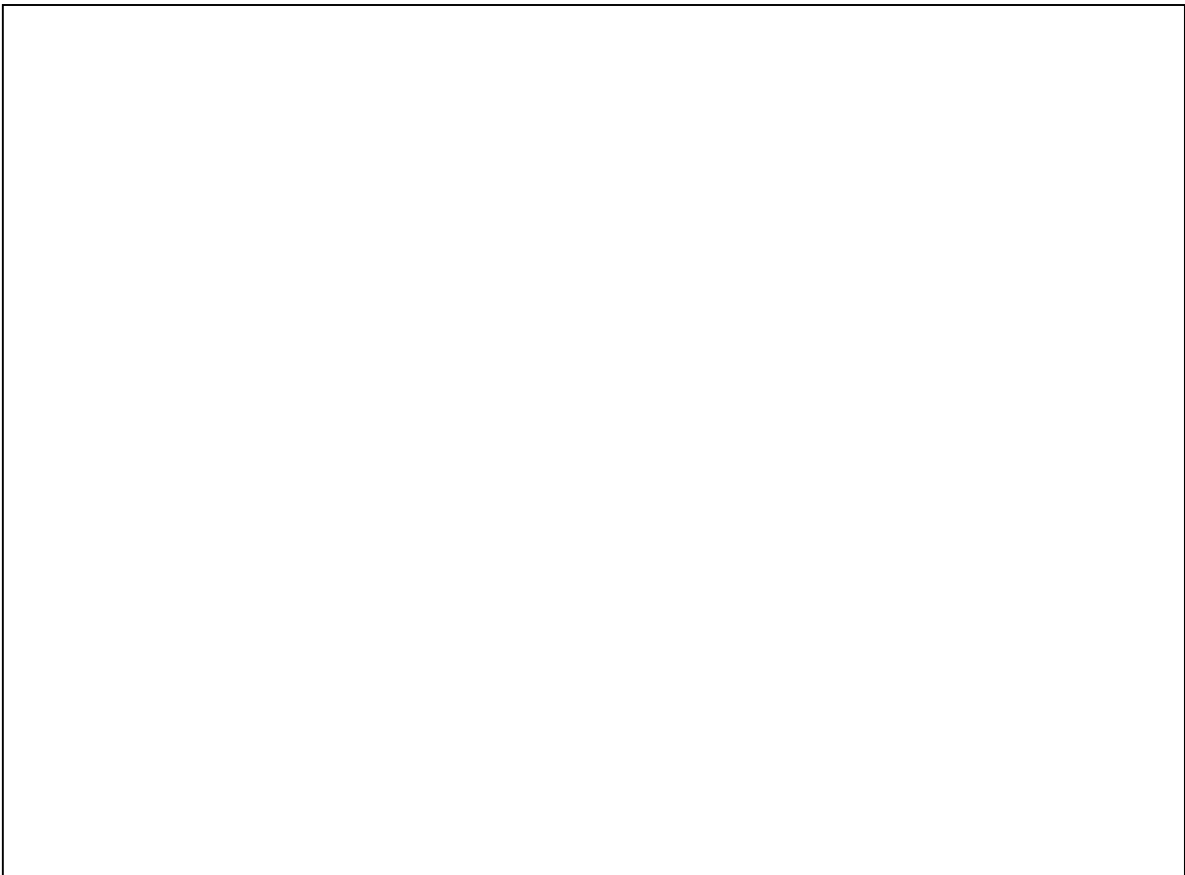
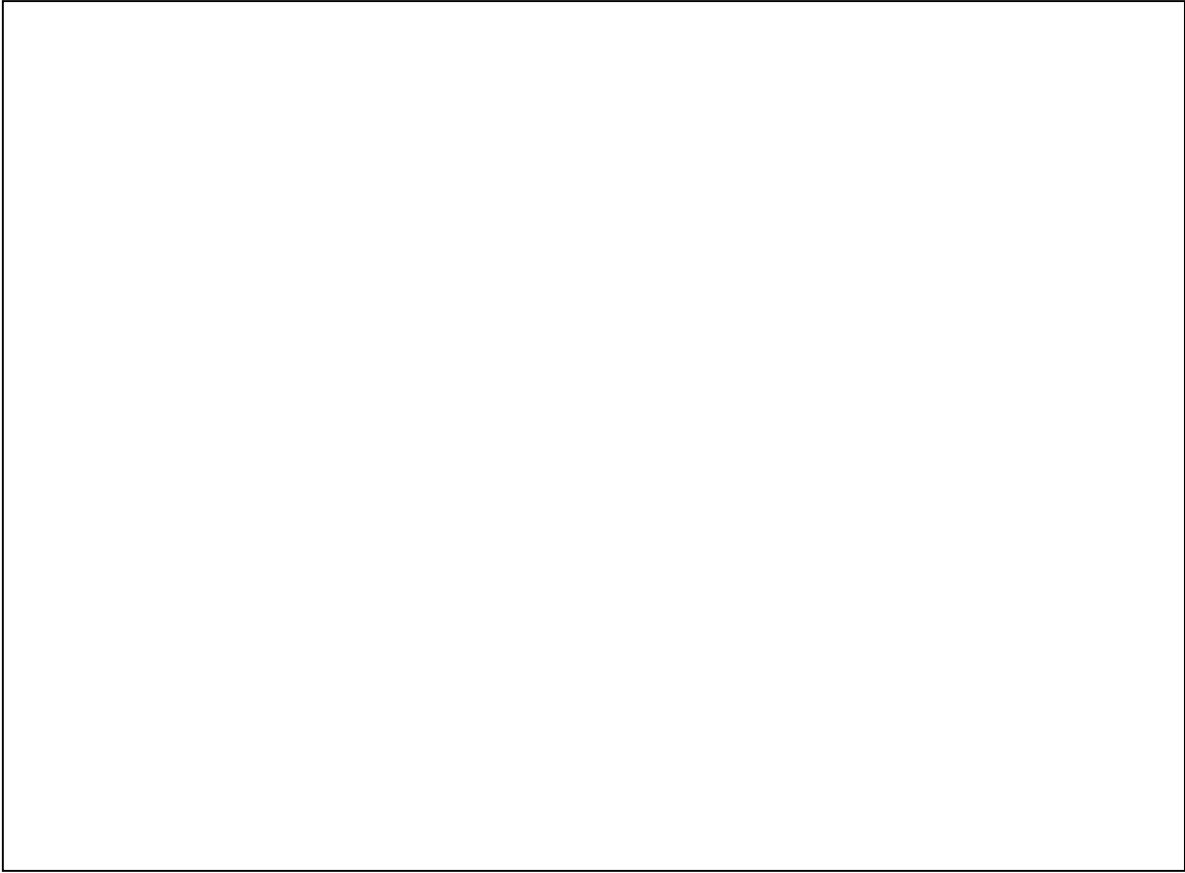
